

**September 2014
Parking Subcommittee Meeting**

- Mark, Jim Sack, Caitlin Brady, Chris, Nancy, Bob, Dwight
- Caitlin, Chris, Mark testified this morning. meeting - talked about involvement of TLRC in looking at who does not follow law and lies - who enforces this? This now sits with them according to Mark.
- A question was asked about someone who cannot pay the fine?
- We need to have the entire section deleted and restated with the new one. Asked Mark to send email to us with striking the entire section. Mark will send in word format so it can be completed. There are two pieces. The other piece is the stopping for those with disabilities - this is not a part of this committee.
- Asking AG to send out letter? New MTC is coming and will contain the 2014 changes. Here is the statute - this is not yet set. What about using DRCOG instead?
- Gina contacted DOLA - list of cities - not updated
- ASK a legislator to CML for a list of cities and municipalities get name and address of the clerk, etc. - Todd or Steadman - Mark will ask Sen Todd
- Jeffco adopting and caught error in Jeffco adoption, Commissioner Tighe is aware of it and has been asked to update with 2014.
- Have the cities adopted MTC - if so which version
- If not, copy of ordinance on parking
- Cities - check on line or call if needed - this is the easy to find on line since cities don't really know
- Gina checked on three: Arvada has 2010, Golden has 2010 and Westminster does not adopt any at all.
- Nancy: Did not look on line - Lakewood already done - but will look again
- Nancy will look at Colorado Springs, Thornton,
- Dwight: Centennial, Lone Tree, Parker,
- Mark: Lakeside, Edgewater, Sheridan
- Katelynn: Northglenn, Broomfield, Brighton
- Chris: Boulder, Longmont, Superior,
- Jim: Steamboat Springs, Vail and Breckenridge
- Bob: Douglas - Highlands Ranch, and other areas where they don't have their own law enforcement - Castle Rock, Pueblo, Larkspur, Arapahoe County,
- In little towns there really isn't parking or meters since they are not needed.
- Article for CML - more discussion - who can write - timing with RFP - do we want to wait to see if they can do it?
- What do we expect from this article?
- Is this committee going to write?
- Can we get a city attorney to write an article? Nancy will ask her attorney to see if anyone has reported on it on the magazine yet. Sam Memmet - Nancy will call him

about this piece. - Mark Radkey - Leg Liaison - General Council is Jeff Wilson, Dave Broadwell is Deputy Director

- It might be best to have a City Attorney to write the article. This could be a request to the Arvada City Attorney to write if one has not been done.
- Denver still refusing to implement - only parking - CCDC and a few others are taking this as civil rights issue - they may end up taking this to court with a few cities.
- Boulder - Can Mark set up a meeting with advocates there? Dale Garr? Mark will try to call him and ask him to contact me.
- State meeting for CML - we missed it. still looking for 2015 time frame.

- Follow up: Denver City Council - Ed is interested in cross pollination with the Council. Who is going to follow up? Chris will follow up and this committee asked that he take Julia with him to the meeting since she has already been working with her Council person and tried to talk to Ed in the past.

- Mayors Commission for Persons with Disabilities - HB 1029 is on the next agenda. Gina hooked up Tony Frazzini at Denver Dept of Finance with the City of Arvada so he can see that the 350.00 fines are not a fiscal liability for cities who adopt,

- Sounds like the new line is that the fine is out of line with other fines.

- If they are willing to change the way the program is run, have they told the Rockies staff not to park in the spots at ANY time? Have they done any education? Have they patrolled the spots around the capitol used for employee parking? Another warning letter from the state DPA? Can DPA sanction an employee for violations of parking? Gina will ask. Also follow up to see if the fines are being corrected.

- What does the Gov office say about all of this including enforcement on capitol property. CSP enforces only about 20 spaces - 6 are in the Circle. Sargent at Arms enforces and write tickets for these spaces.

- We have received placards from DMV for training. Can we go to the City staff? yes - lets go to the city and see what we can do to get this done - commend them! Gina, Julia and Chris will follow up.
