- Ideas for spending the parking funds will be presented to the council in August and voted on in September.
- Pat asked if any newspapers or radio stations ran the campaign. Chris replied that Colorado independent ran something that really only referenced the video. No other news coverage that we know of. There has been feedback from some legislatures that have seen the ads.
- Gina asked permission to hire a couple of teens with disabilities to put the swag together not to exceed \$1,000.00. Bob made motion to approve Nancy 2nded. Passed unanimously.
